
Celebrate Local Business With Us!

Tell us about your business - when did you start it and what is it all about?

Niche Planning Studio is a boutique town planning and design consultancy with offices located within the former Funge and Sons bakery on Smith Street, Collingwood. We started in 2012 with one full time staff member and have grown to a staff of eight who work a combination of full time, part time and contract to ensure an efficient work life balance. We provide a variety of statutory and strategic planning services across Australia, including planning permit preparation for small and large clients. Our specialty, however, is in broad acre structure planning and subdivision design for greenfield land located within the urban growth boundary.

What inspired you to start your business?

After 15 years' experience working in local government and private consultancy across Australia, I wanted to create a team of young, driven and enthusiastic town planners who

were skilled in statutory and strategic planning and, like me, understood the development constraints of a site but wanted to work together with government and private clients to get the best outcome possible. After three years we are now working with a broad variety of clients making our day to day job challenging and fun!

Why did you choose to start/locate your business in Collingwood?

The Fitzroy/Collingwood area is a burgeoning design district. With other design affiliated professionals nearby, the area is always a buzz with innovation and new ideas. It's also a great neighbourhood to take out clients for a coffee meeting, particularly if they are normally situated in the City or St Kilda Road!

What is your favourite thing about Collingwood?

We love the Collingwood community vibe and are strongly supportive of our local community providing planning assistance to local residents and business owners alike.
